Newborn and Age 1 | B-3

Loving workers tend to the needs of these little ones while their parents attend other activities. Parents must be on the premises.

Little Lambs, Age 2 and 3 | A-4

Anxious to learn about God’s love for them, this group looks forward to a Bible story, singing, crafts, snacks and playful interaction. Parents must be on the premises.

Beginners, Age 4, 5 and Kindergarten | A-7

Excitement, questions, a desire to try new things, plus wanting to learn more about God characterizes this fast-moving age group. These children begin to learn how

God is interested in every area of their lives through Bible stories, singing, crafts and snack time.
