Newborn to Age 3 | B-3

Loving workers tend to the needs of our little ones through age 3. Reading books, learning to play well together in an atmosphere filled with God's love, makes this a profitable time for this age group. Parents must be on the premises.

Beginners, Age 4, 5 and Kindergarten | A-7

Excitement, questions, a desire to try new things, plus wanting to learn more about God characterizes this fast-moving age group. These children begin to learn how God is interested in every area of their lives through Bible stories, singing, crafts and snack time.
