SIT AT JESUS' FEET

## Introduction:

- Did you ever hear an old, familiar phrase and think, "Where did that come from?"
- There is an often-used phrase in the Gospels that deserves our attention: Sitting at Jesus' feet.
- Let me show you what it means and why it is so important.

## Sitting At Jesus' Feet is the Place of \_\_\_\_\_.

And [Martha] had a sister called Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet and listened to his teaching (Luke 10:39).

*Sat (literally "sitting")*

*Listened to His teaching*

## Indicators I'm NOT sitting and learning at Jesus' feet:

1. I care more and more about what is \_\_\_\_\_ important.  
*But Martha was distracted with much serving (v. 40a).*
  
2. I develop a \_\_\_\_\_ towards other people in my life.  
*"Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to serve alone?" (v. 40b)*

## Sitting At Jesus' feet is the Place of \_\_\_\_\_.

And they put [the lame, the blind, the crippled, the mute, and many others] at his feet, and he healed them (Matthew 15:30).

And [Jairus] fell at his feet and implored him earnestly... (Mark 5:22-23).

## What is Crippling You?

2. \_\_\_\_\_ Him earnestly until He answers.
