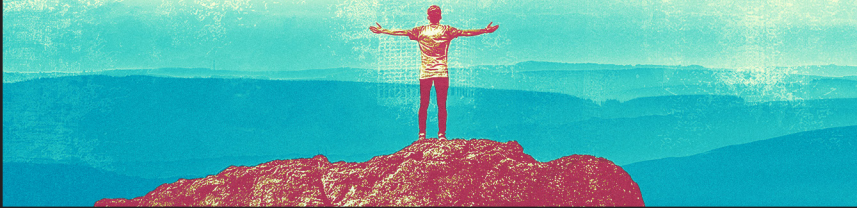


LIVING WITH INTENTION
