



The ABCs of Personal Revival

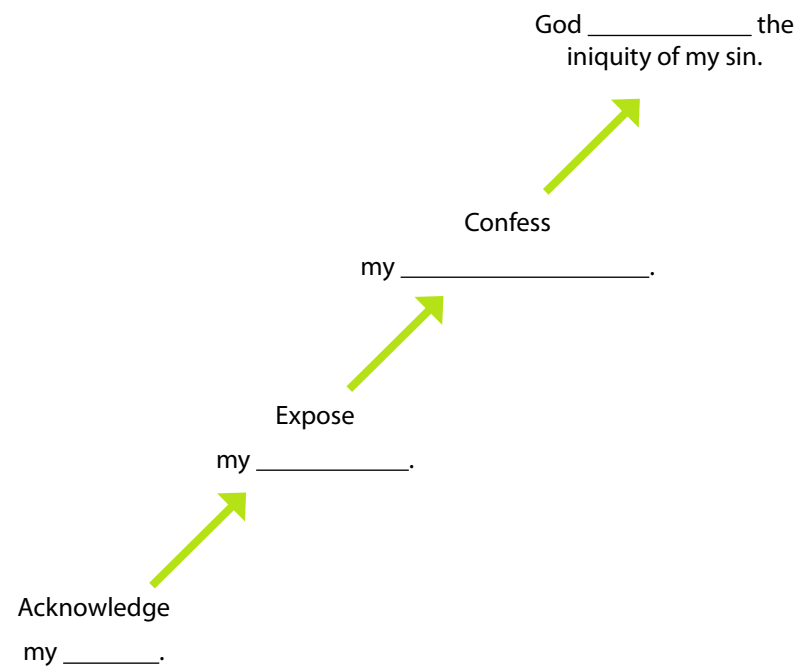
Introduction:
