## Introduction:

- The resurrection narratives are some of the most fascinating passages in the entire Bible.
- This morning, as we look at Mark's account of Jesus' resurrection, I want to answer four questions that come to my mind.

## What Was On Their \_\_\_\_\_?

...they went to the tomb (Mark 16:2).

Seek \_\_\_\_\_ and what you "want" – contentment, peace, and joy – will come as a result.

## What Was On Their \_\_\_\_\_?

"Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance of the tomb?" (v. 3)

Jesus removed the one thing that kept the women –  
and us – from His presence.

## What Was the Point of Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_?

To roll away the stone of \_\_\_\_\_.

### Back Story:

Jesus's death and resurrection \_\_\_\_\_ the Devil and

## How Can My Stone Be \_\_\_\_\_?

\_\_\_\_\_ to God that you have the Stone of sin in your life and that it separates you from Him. Romans 3:23 says, *all have sinned, and fall short of the glory of God.*

\_\_\_\_\_ that Jesus Christ is the Son of God and that His death and resurrection is the only thing that can roll away your stone. John 3:16 tells us that, *God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.*

\_\_\_\_\_ your life to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

The Bible says, *If you confess with your mouth 'Jesus is Lord', and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation* (Romans 10:9-10). Confessing 'Jesus is Lord' means making Jesus the king of your life. It means putting God in the driver's seat of your life. It's making the decision to let Christ rule in your life from this day forward and walking in complete obedience to His will.
