## Introduction:

- Please turn in your Bibles to *Colossians 2:6-15*.
- Paul was writing to a church that loved Christ but was being influenced by dangerous false teachings.
- Paul reminds us how we've been made alive through Christ's death, burial, and resurrection.

## Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord: (v. 6-7)

- \_\_\_\_\_ – Emphasizes His deity.
- \_\_\_\_\_ – Reminds us of His humanity.
- \_\_\_\_\_ – Speaks to His position of authority and our relation to Him.

– *so walk in him...*

– *rooted in him...*

– *built up in him...*

– *established in the faith...*

– *abounding in thanksgiving...*

## Be on guard against anything not of Christ. (v. 8-10)

### Made alive in Christ! (v. 11-15)

- **Circumcision** – Points us to Christ's \_\_\_\_\_ on the cross. (v. 11)
- **Baptism** – Points us to Christ's \_\_\_\_\_.  
(v. 12)
  - We were dead in our trespasses. (v. 13)
  - Through Christ we've been made alive. (v. 13)
  - He's forgiven all of our trespasses. (v. 13)
  - He's cancelled our debt. (v. 14)
  - He's conquered our enemy. (v. 15)
