## Introduction:

- Please turn in your Bibles to *Colossians 3:18–4:1*.
- Paul wrote to the young Colossian church to remind them of Christ's sufficiency, and to stay faithful to biblical truth.
- In today's passage, Paul discusses practical ways to "do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus" (3:17) in 3 critical areas of our lives.

## Marriage: (v. 18-19)

- Wives: \_\_\_\_\_ to your husbands. (v. 18)
  - It's \_\_\_\_\_ to submit, even if he's \_\_\_\_\_.
- Husbands: \_\_\_\_\_ your wives. (v. 19)
  - Love is more than a feeling – it has biblically defined \_\_\_\_\_ . (1 Corinthians 13:4-8)

## Family: (v. 20-21)

- Children: \_\_\_\_\_ your parents in everything. (v. 20)

– Adult sons and daughters are still to \_\_\_\_\_ their parents.

## Work: (3:22–4:1)
